

EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM TO
THE DONCASTER AND SOUTH HUMBER HEALTHCARE NHS TRUST
(TRANSFER OF TRUST PROPERTY) ORDER 2006

1 This explanatory memorandum has been prepared by the Department of Health and is laid before Parliament by Command of Her Majesty.

2 Description

2.1 The purpose of the Statutory Instrument is to transfer property held on trust (charitable property) from Doncaster and South Humber Healthcare NHS Trust to The Northern Lincolnshire and Goole Hospitals NHS Trust.

4 Legislative Background

4.1 Due to changes in arrangements for the administration of the Doncaster and South Humber Healthcare NHS Trust, it is considered, more appropriate after consultation with both the transferor and transferee trusts, for the Northern Lincolnshire and Goole Hospitals NHS Trust to hold and administer the trust property currently held by the Doncaster and South Humber Healthcare NHS Trust. This instrument, therefore, transfers the trust property currently held by Doncaster and South Humber Healthcare NHS Trust to The Northern Lincolnshire and Goole Hospitals NHS Trust.

5 Extent

5.1 This instrument applies to England.

6 European Convention on Human Rights

As the instrument is subject to negative resolution procedure and does not amend primary legislation, no statement is required.

7 Policy background

7.1 The policy objectives are to transfer trust property, together with any rights and liabilities arising from that property, from the Doncaster and South Humber Healthcare NHS Trust to The Northern Lincolnshire and Goole Hospitals NHS Trust.

8 Impact

8.1 A Regulatory Impact Assessment has not been prepared for this instrument as it has no impact on business, charities or voluntary bodies.
