Auctioneer's firearm permit**Notes**

- 1 Under section 3(2) of the Firearms Act 1968 it is an offence for a person to sell or transfer to any person in the United Kingdom, other than a registered firearms dealer, any firearm or ammunition to which this permit relates, unless that other person produces a firearm certificate authorising him to purchase or acquire it, or shows that he is by virtue of the Firearms Acts entitled to purchase or acquire the firearm or ammunition without holding a certificate.
- 2 Under section 32 of the Firearms (Amendment) Act 1997 where a person sells, lets on hire, lends or gives a firearm or ammunition to which section 1 applies to another person who is not a registered firearms dealer or a person who is entitled to purchase or acquire the firearm or ammunition without holding a certificate –

- i) the person receiving the firearm or ammunition must produce the certificate or permit entitling him/ her to purchase or acquire the firearm or ammunition being transferred;
- ii) the person selling, letting on hire, lending or giving the firearm or ammunition must comply with any instructions in the certificate or permit produced; and
- iii) the final hand over of firearms and ammunition must take place in person.

It is an offence for a person to fail to comply with these requirements.
