The Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 18(8)(a) and (b) of the Employment Tribunals Act 1996<sup>(a)</sup>, hereby makes the following Order:

**Citation and commencement**

1. This Order may be cited as the Employment Tribunals Act (Application of Conciliation Provisions) Order 2000 (Revocation) Order 2000 and comes into force on 19th May 2000.

**Revocation**

2. The Employment Tribunals Act (Application of Conciliation Provisions) Order 2000<sup>(b)</sup> is revoked.
