

Amendment of the Crime (Sentences) Act 1997

3.—(1) The Crime (Sentences) Act 1997 (c. 43) is amended as follows.

(2) In Schedule 1 (transfer of prisoners within the British Isles) in paragraphs 12(2)(a) and (5) and 13(2)(a) and (5) after “1995” insert “or Chapter 4 of Part 2 of the Criminal Justice (Northern Ireland) Order 2008”.

Amendment of the Freedom of Information Act 2000

4. In Part 7 of Schedule 1 to the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (c. 36) (Northern Ireland public bodies)—

(a) omit the entry relating to the Life Sentence Review Commissioners; and

(b) at the appropriate place insert—

“Parole Commissioners for Northern Ireland”.

Amendment of the International Criminal Court Act 2001

5.—(1) The International Criminal Court Act 2001 (c. 17) is amended as follows.

(2) In Schedule 7 (domestic provisions not applicable to ICC prisoners) in paragraph 3(2) at the end insert—

“Chapter 4 of Part 2 of the Criminal Justice (Northern Ireland) Order 2008 (release on licence of certain prisoners).”.

This Order makes amendments to the law of the United Kingdom which are consequential on Part 2 of the Criminal Justice (Northern Ireland) Order 2008. That Part provides for extended and indeterminate custodial sentences for certain offences and for the release on licence of persons serving custodial sentences.
